

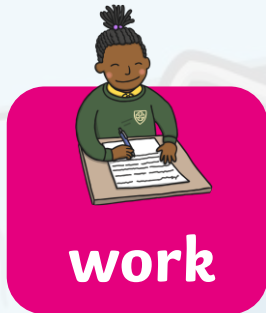
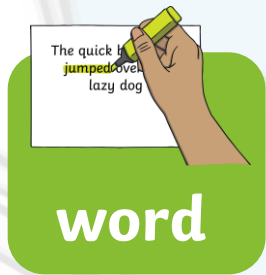
# The /er/ Sound Spelt With 'or' and the /or/ Sound Spelt With 'ar'



# The Stressed /er/ Spelt 'or'

We have learnt that the /er/ sound can be spelt with 'er', 'ir' and 'ur' but to spell the /er/ sound after the letter 'w', we use a different spelling pattern.

The /er/ sound can also be spelt with 'or' if it comes **after the letter 'w'**.  
**There are not many of these words.**

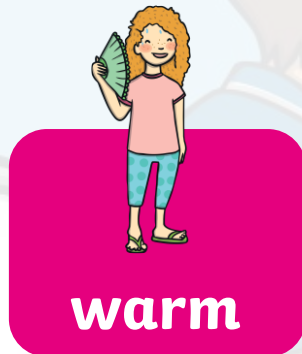

Similarly, the /or/ sound can be spelt with the 'ar' letter pattern if it comes after a letter 'w'.

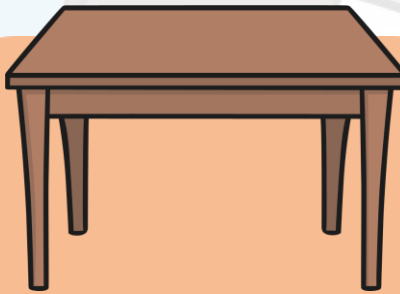
**There are not many of these words either.**



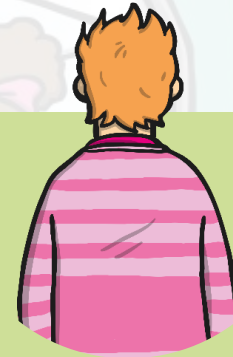
# The /er/ Sound Spelt With 'or' and the /or/ Sound Spelt With 'ar'
