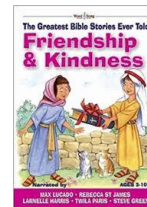

Reading

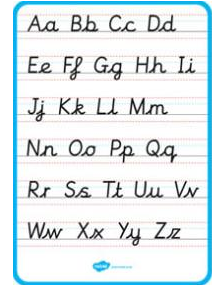
Read the extract about Space and answer the questions.

Queen Elizabeth II has just celebrated her 95th birthday. Using her as the figurehead, create her family tree that includes 4 generations

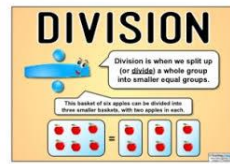

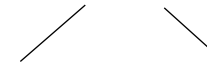

If you are struggling to complete the work online, get in touch and I'll see what I can do to get you a paper copy.

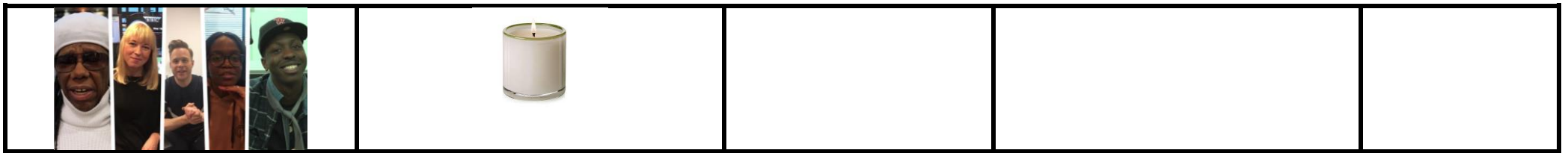
