Write a prayer thanking God for all he created and asking him to guide those who drop litter, fly tip set fires etc.

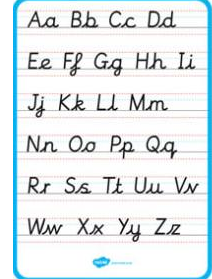


Reading

Maths/English

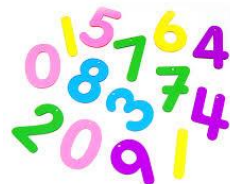
COUNTDOWN
