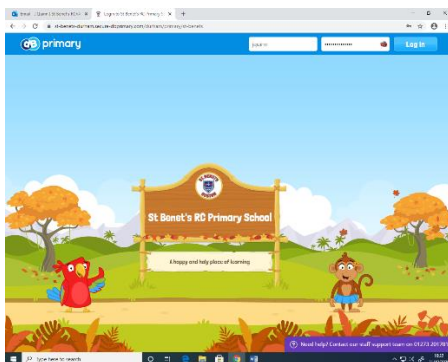
As you may be aware, at school we have recently started using an online learning platform called '**Db Primary.**' All of the children have registered accounts that can be used to access work and communicate with their class teacher and classmates.

All of the children should, by now, have had at least one session with their class teacher looking at how to access Db Primary and log on to their individual account. They may have also had some time to explore the different features and attempt a variety of activities.

Db Primary will allow us as a school to set work and activities online. Children will be able to complete the tasks and receive feedback when necessary all without having to print any material or return anything to school. The work on Db Primary may take many forms such as a blog entry, a written task, a research activity, responding to a survey or forum post, practising spellings or completing a quiz for example.

Db Primary also functions as an excellent way for children to communicate with their class teacher in the event that the school or a year group bubble needs to self-isolate.

The children should have already been issued with a username and password.

From this screen they will be able to enter their username and password and it should take them to their own personal page, which will be linked to their year group page.

Over the half term holiday, please encourage your child to log in to Db Primary and complete some of the tasks and work set by their class teacher and explore the platform to familiarise themselves with all it has to offer.
